Key Academic Achievements and Developments

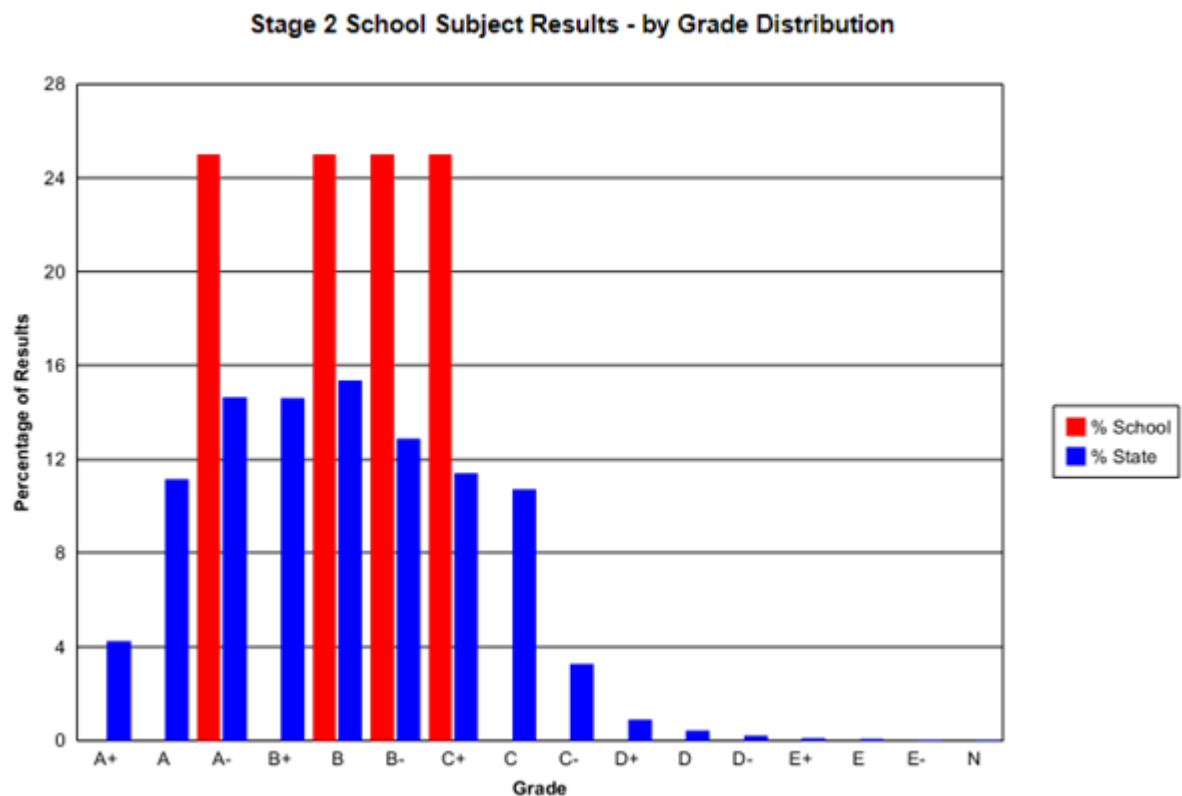


NAPLAN

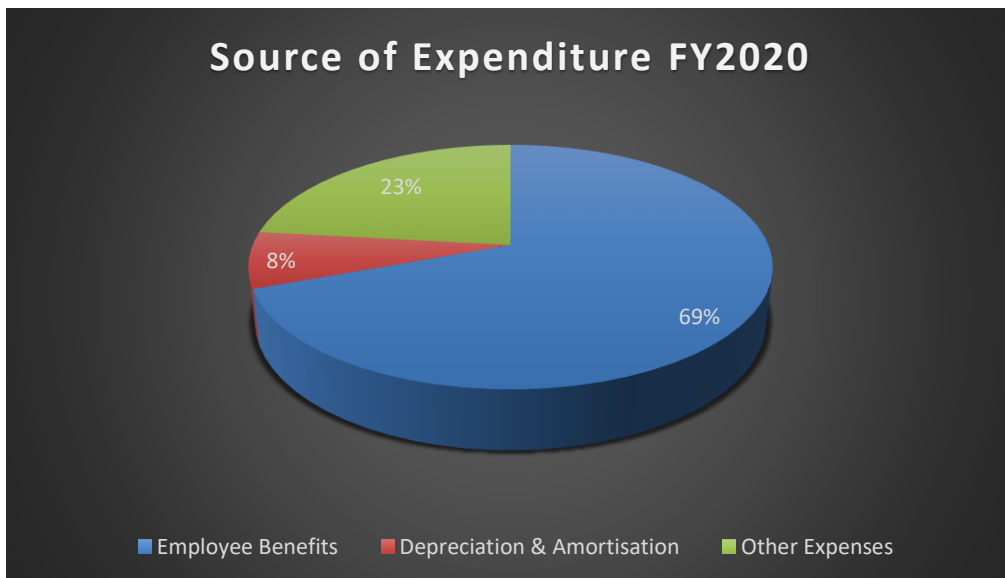
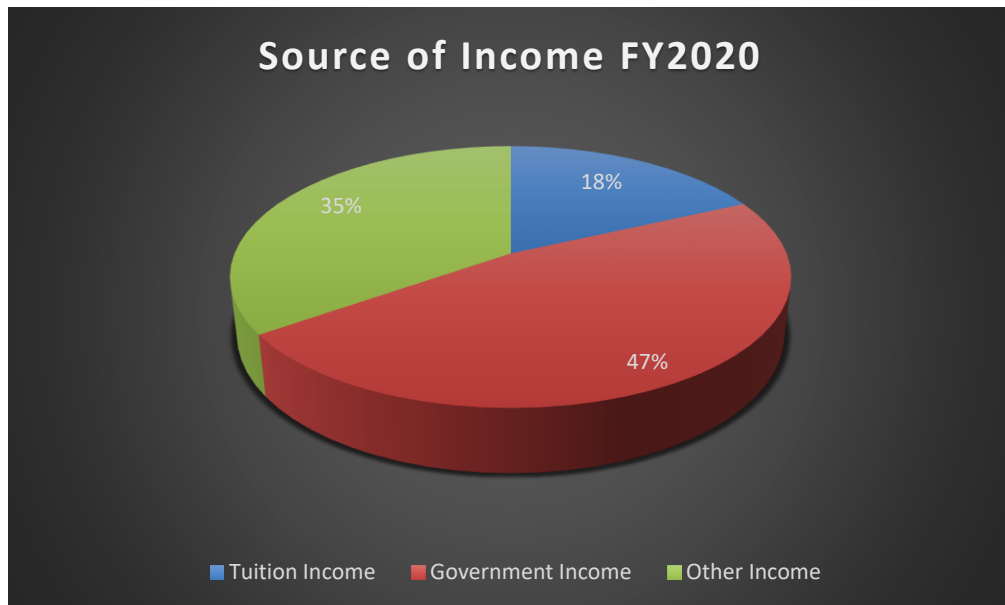


Vocational Education & Training
